## Glow Friendship Bracelets

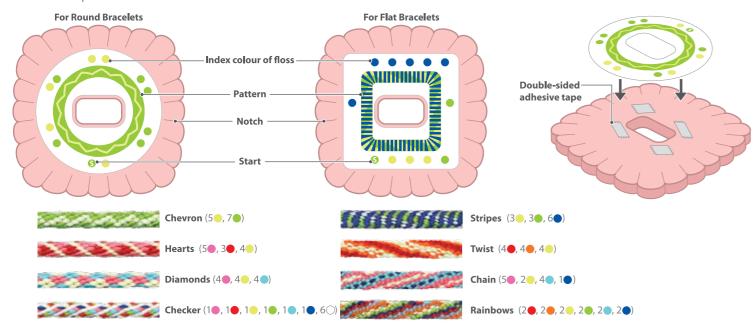


## A. CONTENTS

Contents: 1 friendship bracelet wheel, 7 spools of coloured embroidery floss, 2 spools of glow embroidery floss, 8 patterned templates, double-sided adhesive tape and detailed instructions. (You will need a pair of scissors from home to cut the floss. Adult supervision is required.)

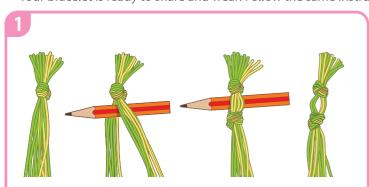
## **B. PREPARATION**

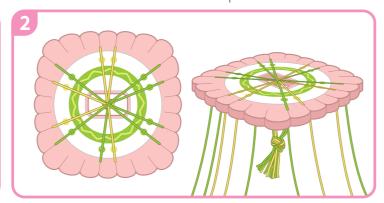
There are 4 round templates for making round bracelets and 4 square templates with rounded corners for making flat bracelets. Previews of the bracelet patterns are printed on the templates. We recommend that you start out by making round bracelets as they are easier. You can make a bracelet using the colours shown on the template, or create your own colour combination. A total of 12 strands of embroidery floss are required to finish a bracelet. The materials we provide will make 12 bracelets. You may expand your collection with additional embroidery floss from home or by purchasing more from a craft store. To start off, apply double-sided adhesive tapes to secure a template on the wheel.



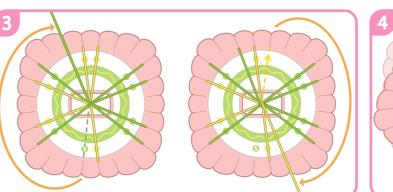
## C. ROUND BRACELETS INSTRUCTIONS

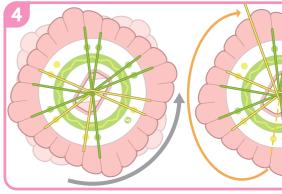
- 1. We will use the Chevron pattern for this demonstration. Cut 7 strands of green floss and 5 strands of glow floss into 50 cm pieces. Lay all of the strands over top of each other, gather them up together at one end, make a knot, and then divide the strands in half. Place a pencil between the halves, gather them together, and knot the entire bunch of floss again. This creates a loop knot for your bracelet. For each of the strands of glow floss, tie a knot at the other end to prevent them from fraying.
- 2. Insert the knotted end of the floss in the centre of the wheel. Hook the 12 strands into the notches of the wheel, taking care to match the coloured spots as illustrated in the diagram. You are now ready to start braiding.
- 3. Unhook the floss from the starting notch, bring it up to the top of the wheel and hook the floss into the notch on the left-hand side of the petal. You will find that you have formed a group of 3 floss strands. Unhook the group's rightmost strand and hook it back onto the notch immediately to the right of the single strand of floss at the bottom.
- 4. Turn the counter-clockwise and repeat step 3. Remember to turn your wheel counter-clockwise after each repetition of step 3. (Note: Ensure that the braided bracelet remains at the centre and that the floss strands are tight when braiding.) When you begin to run out of floss or the bracelet is long enough, simply unhook all your floss strands and gather them to make a knot. Trim the ends neatly. Your bracelet is ready to share and wear! Follow the same instructions to create the other round bracelet patterns.

- 1. We will use the Stripes pattern for this demonstration. Cut 6 strands of blue floss, 3 strands of green floss and 3 strands of glow floss. Repeat steps C1 and C2 to make the loop knot and hook the strands into the notches of the wheel. You are now ready to start braiding.
- 2. Unhook the floss from the starting notch, bring it up to the top of the wheel and hook it into the left-hand notch of the floss group. Move the next floss at the top wheel down to the starting notch.
- 3. At the bottom of the wheel, unhook the second strand from the left and bring it up to the empty notch of the top floss group. Move the next strand over at the top of the wheel down to the empty notch of the bottom group of floss strands.
- 4. Continue this braiding pattern by moving the floss up and down to the empty notches, until the last, rightmost strand of the top floss group is moved to the wheel bottom. (Note: Ensure that the braided bracelet remains at the centre and that the floss strands are tight when braiding.)
- 5. Unhook the single floss strand on the right side of the wheel, and bring it up to the rightmost empty notch of the top floss group. Move the single floss strand on the left side of the wheel to the right side.
- 6. Bring the leftmost strand of the top floss group to the empty notch on the left side of the wheel. Now repeat steps 2-5 to continue braiding. When you begin to run out of floss or the bracelet is long enough, simply unhook all your floss strands and gather them to make a knot. Trim the ends neatly. Your bracelet is ready to share and wear! Follow the same instructions to create the other flat bracelet patterns.
