Ages : 5 to 10
Number of players: 2-4
Number of cards: 36 cards
Aim of the game: to be the first player to get rid of all of their cards.

Getting the game ready: The cards are shuffled. The dealer deals 6 cards to each player and turns over 1 card in the middle of the table; the rest of the cards, placed face-down, make up the pack.

Playing the game: the game is played in a clockwise manner. The youngest player starts. Each player looks in their hand to seek if one of their cards has an element that matches the card in the middle of the table. This matching element can be:

- the clothes
- the hat (shape + colour)
- the cheeks (pattern + colour)

- If the player has a card which has an element that matches the card in the middle of the table, they put that card on top of it. They can also put a second card on top of it. It is then the next player's turn.
- If they cannot go, they pick up a card from the pack.
- If this card is a good one, they play this card and can then put down a second card if their hand so permits.
- If the card they pick up is not a good one, it is the next player's turn to play 1 or 2 cards.

End of the game: the winner is the first player to get rid of all of their cards.
