

SPIDIFISH



Age: 4 to 8 years



Number of players: 2



Contents: 18 cards + 3 cards in the shape of fish.




Object: To catch the right fish as quickly as possible to win all the cards.




Rules of the game: Deal out all cards between the players and let the fish cards float freely in the bath.


Players hold their deck of cards face down in their hands and then they simultaneously turn over the top card from their deck:



One player turns up a "naked" fish and the other a T-shirt,



One player turns up a "naked" fish and the other a colour,



One player turns up a "naked" fish and the other a pattern.

In these 3 cases, the players try to catch the fish wearing the same T-shirt, the same colour or the same pattern as the one on the card.

The first to catch it wins her opponent's card. She then places the 2 cards at the bottom of her deck and the game resumes.

In all other cases, nothing happens. Players put their cards at the bottom of their decks and immediately turn over a new card.

If, in the heat of the moment, a player catches a fish for no reason (she thought she saw the right combination of cards or she catches a fish wearing a T-shirt of the wrong colour), she gives her card to her opponent as a penalty.

The game ends:

- when the bathwater is cold. Both players count their cards. Whoever has the most wins.

OR

- when one of the 2 players has won all of her opponent's cards.
